

HOW TO PREPARE FOR A FLEA SERVICE

These recommendations are offered as a courtesy to help prepare you prior to your flea treatment (this includes regular flea service and service calls):

- 1. Remove everything from floors including toys, magazines, pillows and any other items so that all areas, especially carpeted areas, can be treated.
- 2. Remove all articles from under beds, on closet floors and under furniture, as these areas are where flea eggs, larvae, and pupae normally develop.
- 3. Vacuum **ALL** floors and upholstered furniture to remove all animal hair and any other debris.
- 4. Remove vacuum cleaner bag, place in a plastic bag and dispose of outside the home.
- 5. Remove birds or any other pets. Cover aquariums with a small towel and turn off aquarium pumps. (NO LIVING, BREATHING THING CAN BE ON PREMISES TO BE TREATED.)
- 6. Be prepared to leave the home for two to three hours when the service specialist arrives. Your carpets and furniture may be a little damp after the service.
- 7. It is always recommended that you have your pet(s) **treated** the day that your home is serviced.
- 8. Upon returning home, open a few doors and windows to supply cross ventilation to your home and to help eliminate any remaining odor. We try to use the most odorless product that we can.
- 9. Old pet bedding should be discarded or washed in hot water and replaced with clean, fresh, bedding.

If you follow these recommendations, then you can help us to help rid your home of fleas with the fewest treatments possible. Control will be ineffective unless ALL precautions are taken.
